## However, the above sanction shall be subject to the terms and conditions as given here under:-

- 1. The User Agency and or its contractors will not bring any forest area under their use, other than the actual area / activity approved by the Government for the instant proposal. Any laxity or deviation on this account by the user agency or its contractors will attract penal provisions of the relevant Acts / legal provisions.
- 2. The user Agency had made the full payment summarized below, as reported by the Nodal Officer FCA, vide letter mentioned at Ref. (iii).

- 3. (i) The extraction of the trees /poles/saplings shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/ Divisional Forest Officer concerned on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Director, Soil & Water Conservation Department, J&K/ Chief Conservator of Forests, Kashmir. The marking for tree-felling will be done in consultation with the User Agency and effort shall be made to save most of the trees. The extraction charges shall be paid by the User Agency directly to the agency executing the extraction.
  - (ii) The fundamental rule for marking of trees, enumerated during processing of the instant proposal, will be to save maximum number of trees out of the trees approved herewith for felling without compromising with the construction and maintenance of the approved project structures and no trees will be felled/ cut/pruned/lopped for purposes/ project activities other than those approved / sanctioned.
- 4. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its contractors shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate.
- 5. The User Agency shall pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined as per decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

- 6. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
- 7. The User Agency shall get the State land provided by the Dy. Commissioner concerned for carrying out the afforestation works mutated in favour of the Forest Department before execution of the work.
