Terms and conditions:-

- (i) The User Agency shall not be allowed to fell or damage any tree/pole/sapling in the forest land allowed for use.
- (ii) Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charge from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- (iii) The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
- (iv) The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
- (v) a) The User Agency shall clear FCA outstanding amounting to Rs. 26, 29,780 for the cases sanctioned earlier.
b) The CCF, Kashmir shall pursue with Revenue Authorities for assessment of compensation of land in the earlier cases of Army Authorities (Kashmir Province).
c) This is in line with the assurance given by the Commissioner/Secretary (Forests) to the CAG Public Accounts Committee in the meeting held on 10.11.2012.
- (vi) The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- (vii) The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged. The forest Department officials shall be given secured access for routine inspections as and when required.
- (viii) The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.




