Terms and conditions:-

i. Legal and proprietary status of the forest land will remain unchanged

ii. The forest land will not be used for any other purpose other than that mentioned in the proposal.

iii. The User Agency and Forest Department shall comply with the terms and conditions enlisted in the letter conveying Stage-II approval issued by Regional Officer, IRO Jammu, (MoEFCC) mentioned at Ref. 3 (copy enclosed).

Regarding extraction, following shall be the procedure: iv.

a) The extraction of the trees/poles/saplings shall be done by the J&K Forest Development Corporation/Divisional Forest Officer concerned on the basis of markings administratively approved by the competent authority. The marking for tree felling will be done in consultation with the user agency and effort shall be made to save maximum number of trees/poles/saplings. The cost of extraction shall be paid by the user agency directly to the agency executing the extraction.

b) The fundamental rule for marking of trees, enumerated during processing of the proposals, will be to save maximum number of trees without compromising with the construction and maintenance of the approved project structure and no trees/poles/saplings will be felled/cut/pruned/lopped for purposes/project activities

other than those approved/sanctioned.

No damage will be done to the adjoining forest land and all efforts shall be made to save the adjoining forest and forest land.

The User Agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the vi. Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, and any other clearances under relevant Acts/ Rules/court's Rulings/instructions, etc., as applicable to this proposal

The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any vii.

encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.

Any other condition that MoEFCC or its Regional Office may stipulate, from time to time, in viii. the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.



Please refer to the above cited subject and letters seeking prior approval of the Central government for the diversion of Forest land for non-forestry purpose in accordance with section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. Vide this office letter of even no dated 28.12.2021 in principle approval was accorded. The compliance of stage-I was received vide letter no. FST-Land0FC/109/2021-02 Dated 23.08.2022

- 2. After careful examination of the proposal of the UT Administration, approval is hereby conveyed for diversion of 1.9891 ha of forest land for the above-mentioned project, subject to the following conditions;
 - i. Legal status of the forest land will remain unchanged.
 - Minimum number of trees/plants and in any case not more than 30 trees and 762
 poles in Kathua division and 44 trees and 454 poles in Samba division will be
 felled.
 - iii. The UT Govt shall upload the KML files of the degraded forest area accepted for raising compensatory afforestation as well as the forest area proposed for diversion in the extant proposal in the E-Green watch portal.
 - No muck shall be dumped in the forest land in context of the undertaking submitted by User Agency.
 - v. The DFO shall ensure that user agency shall not dump muck on forest land.
 - vi. The forest land will not be used for any other purpose than that mentioned in the proposal.

- The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be 1/10497/2022 transferred to any other agency, department, or persons without approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.
 - The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior viii. approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.
 - The user agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road ix. at the project cost as per IRC specification with maintenance of seven to ten years.
 - No damage will be done to the adjoining forest land. X.
 - No labour camp shall be established on the forest land. xi.
 - The user agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased on the XII. order of Hon'ble Supreme Court.
 - The User Agency shall provide firewood preferably alternate fuels to the labourers xiii. and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.
 - Compensatory afforestation will be carried out in two different patches of Degraded xiv. Forest Land (DFL) in two districts/forest divisions involved-upon 2.65 ha in Samba district on Comp no. 15/D, Village-Sumbli, Tehsil- Bari Brahmana, District-Samba at the cost of Rs.5,30,000 and upon 2 ha in Kathua district on Comp no. 75/J, Jasrota forest range, Tehsil- Hiranagar, District- Kathua at the cost of Rs.4,00,000 paid by the User Agency.
 - DFO shall ensure that compensatory afforestation will be done within one year from XV. final approval over the extent of land as approved, out of the funds provided by the user agency.
 - The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the xvi. project cost, as per the direction of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
 - No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation xvii. of construction material for execution of the project work.
 - Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change xviii. may stipulate from the time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
 - It will be the responsibility of the UT Administration/User Agency to obtain all xix. other prior approvals/clearances under all other relevant Acts/Rules/ Court's rulings/instructions, etc. including environmental clearance, as applicable to this proposal.
 - The Ministry may revoke/suspend the clearance if implementation of any of the above 3. conditions is not satisfactory. UT Administration shall ensure fulfilment of these conditions through forest department.
