CAMPA.

Sir/Madam,

The CAMPA Secretariat is planning to hold meetings of its Executive and Steering Committees in November end and mid December 2020 respectively. The agenda of these meetings shall include review of implementation of the approved Annual Plan of Operations (APOs) in the current and the previous financial years, and proposals for the next financial year.


2. In this connection, all implementing agencies are requested to provide the following inputs:

- i) Good quality properly labeled/captioned photographs of works executed in the current and the last financial years along with a brief write-up (less than 5 sentences) about the work shown in the photograph. The photographs and write-ups shall reflect wide range of regular/innovative activities funded under CAMPA: eco-restoration of fragile areas, conservation of RET species & biodiversity conservation, upgradation of nurseries, silvicultural operations to augment natural regeneration, fire management, soil & water conservation, fencing/planting of forest areas retrieved from encroachment, demarcation works, infrastructure development and capacity building activities.

- ii) Carefully chosen before and after intervention photographs showing visible impact of intervention along with a brief note describing the intervention. Satellite imagery of the site, before and after intervention, will lend credence to the claim of improvement resulting from intervention.
- iii) Photographs showing consultation with Panchayats and benefits accruing to the inhabitants living in the proximity of intervention sites (in terms of grass/fodder, MFP and firewood/timber) shall be deeply appreciated.
- iv) Executive and Steering Committees include representatives of Tribal Development, Rural Development , Agriculture, Panchayati Raj & Science Technology. Our activities showing interface with these departments/their stakeholders (in particular, nomadic tribes) will be appreciated by members of these committees.

3. It is requested to kindly provide the above inputs to the CAMPA Secretariat through email/pen drive latest by 20 November 2020.
