Sub: Requisition for release of funds in FY 2021-22 for Catchment Area Treatment under the Project "River Rejuvenation of J&K".

Sir,

The Catchment Area Treatment Plan (Afforestation component of the Action Plan) prepared by the River Rejuvenation Committee (constituted in compliance to directions of Hon'ble NGT) was placed before the Steering Committee of J&K CAMPA in its 17th meeting held on 8 June 2019 for funding. The Steering Committee approved an outlay of Rs 550.00 lakh for Catchment Area Treatment Plan for polluted stretches of main rivers of J&K, namely, Tawi, Chenab, Devika, Basanter, Banganga, Sindh and Jehlum for execution of works by the J&K Forest Department during the financial years 2019-20 and 2020-21.

2. A total of Rs 495.81 lakh against the approved outlay of Rs 550.00 lakh has been released during 2019-20 and 2020-21 from J&K CAMPA funds. Division-wise physical/ financial targets and amount release by J&K CAMPA is given in the following table.
