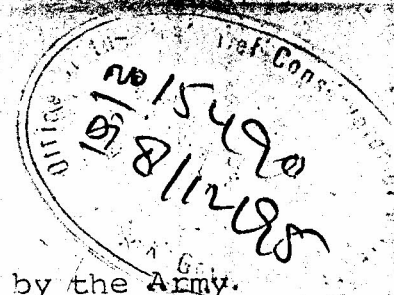

Sanction is accorded to the transfer of Forest land measuring 4.37 Hectares in Forest Division Jammu to the Project Sampark for construction of Nagrota Bye-Pass road on the following terms and Conditions:-

- HAA
1. The Project Sampark will contribute towards the compensatory afforestation/Soil Conservation measuring at Rs.10,000 per Hectt, for an area of 19.43 Hectt.
- ii. The user agency will pay the compensation of trees which require removal to the extent of Rs.60,270-70 and the stuff will vest to the Forest Department.
- iii. The user agency shall have to pay the cost of Forest land Viz.4.37 Hectt; as will be determined by the collector.
- iv. The user Agency shall not increase road width beyond 10 Mts inclusive of berms and drains.
- v. The Protection measures such as breast retaining walls cross and side drainage etc. shall be constructed side by side of formation of the road
