Subject:- Acquisition of Forest land by GREF authorities for establishment of office Residential purposes at village Bathuni ( Area already occupied)

Reference:- Cabinet Decision No: 3/1 Dated 31.1.2001.

Sanction is accorded to the transfer of Forest Land measuring 44 kanals, 19 marlas falling in Compt. No: 39-40/R of Rajouri Forest Division for establishment of office/residential purpose at village Bathuni ( area already occupied) to the GREF authorities on the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the user agency will pay the compensation for trees of different species calculated @ two times the standard rate of 1992.
2. That the cost of the land as would be assessed by the Revenue Department shall be recovered from the user agency.
3. That user agency will pay towards compensatory afforestation @ Rs. 10,000 per hac.
4. That the proprietary status of Forest land shall remain unchanged.
5. That any damage of trees done by the user agency will be charged @ ten times of the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.
6. That the user agency will construct complete retaining/ breast walls on the both sides of the roads and take other necessary steps so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips.
7. That the trees to be removed will be handed over to SFC for extraction.
