**Subject:** Permission for cutting of trees along railway line between Lakhanpur-Vijaypur coming in Madhupur Punjab and Jammu - Tawi in connection with doubling of railway line from Jalandhar-Pathankote Jammu Tawi section.

**Ref:** Cabinet Decision No. 45/3 dated 18.4.2005.

Sanction is accorded to the permission for cutting of 1225 trees of different species and dia classes along railway line between Lakhanpur-Vijaypur of Kathua Forest Division, coming in Madhopur-Punjab and Jammu-tawi in connection with doubling of railway line from Jalandhar Pathankot- Jammu Tawi Section on the following terms and conditions.

1. The proprietary status of the land shall remain unchanged.
2. The user agency shall pay Rs.13,62,652/- towards compensation of 1225 trees of different species and dia classes at two times standard rate of 1992.
3. The user agency shall pay Rs.14,00,000/- towards compensatory afforestation to be carried over 115.24 ha.
4. The user agency shall construct complete retaining/breast walls on both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slip.
5. The extraction of trees shall be done by SFC/Forest Department on the basis of the marking list duly approved by the conservator of Forests, working plan circle.
6. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or by its employee, contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency @ ten times of the standard rate or 1992 as penalty.
7. The user agency shall deposit the amount of compensatory afforestation with the Chief Accounts officer in the office of the PCCF, J&K Govt. as per SRO 203 of 2000 dated 13.6.2000. Compensation of the trees felled and the compensation for the damage done shall be deposited with the DFO Kathua.
