Sanction is accorded to the diversion of forest land measuring 6 Kanals and 3 Marlas falling under Compartments No. 1,2 and 3/P of Forest Division Jammu for erection of 33 KV Level Janipur Roop Nagar Line-II by the Power Development Department on the following conditions:-

i. The proprietary status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.

ii. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.

iii. The Forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, re-assigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner whatsoever to any other agency.

iv. The user agency shall pay compensation for land as would be assessed by the concerned DFO as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 30.10.2002 and 01.08.2003 in I.A No. 566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202 of 1995 T.N. Godavarman Thirumalpad V/S Union of India, as per the net present value.

v. The user agency shall be bound to pay an amount of Rs.38,149/- (Rupees thirty eight thousand one hundred and forty nine only) on account of compensation of 73 number of trees of different species and dia classes.

vi. The extraction of trees shall be done by the SFC/Forest Department on the basis of marking list approved by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan and Research Circle

vii. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency @ ten times the standard rate of 1992.

viii. The user agency will construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips

ix. The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department when it is no longer required by the user agency without any costs.

x. The user agency shall pay any other amount which will become payable as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 30.10.2002 and 01.08.2003 in I.A No. 566 in Writ Petition (Civil) 202 of 1995 T.N. Godavarman Thirumalpad V/S Union of India

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 29th meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 06.06.2005.
