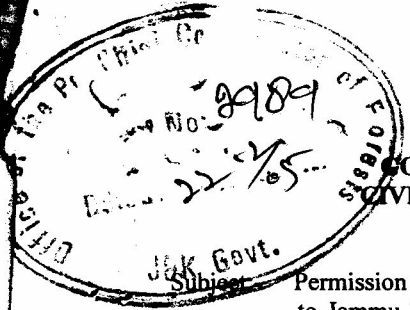

Permission for cutting of trees along Railway line between Madhopur Punjab to Jammu Tawi in connection with doubling of railway line from Jhallandhar to Jammu Tawi.

**GOVERNMENT ORDER NO: 26 /FST OF 2005

Sanction is accorded to the permission for cutting of 212 trees of different broad leaved species/dia classes along Railway line between Madhopur Punjab to Jammu Tawi in connection with doubling of Railway line from Jhallandhar to Jammu Tawi on the following terms and conditions:-

- The user agency shall pay Rs.6,83,682.00 on account of compensation of 212 number of trees of different species/dia classes @ two time of the standard rate of 1992.
- ii. The user agency shall pay Rs.3,50,000.00 towards compensatory afforestation to be carried over 35 Ha. of degraded forest land.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 27th meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 01.12.2004.
