Diversion of Forest Land for construction of approach road from Gran Reasi to Subject:-

Harotekote (Portal PI of T3 Harenkote Tunnel) by Northern Railway.

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO: 29/FST OF 2005 D A T E D / 2005

Sanction is accorded to the diversion of forest land measuring 33.10 kanals (1.655 Ha.) of forest area falling in Compartment No. 35/R and 37/R of Forest Division Reasi for construction of approach road from Gran Reasi to Harotekote (Portal PI of T3 Harotekote Tunnel) on the following terms and conditions:

The proprietary status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.

The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.

iii. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, re-assigned or sub-leased by user

agency in any manner whatsoever to any other agency.

- The user agency shall pay compensation of land on account of change of land use iv. amounting to Rs.99,350/- as assessed by the Revenue Authorities. The payment on account of compensation of land will be made by the user agency only after decision is taken in consultation with the Central Government.
- The user agency shall pay Rs.3,49,212/- on account of compensation of 448 number of trees of different dia-classes @ two times of the standard rate of 1992.
- vi. The user agency shall pay Rs.89,381/-on account of Compensatory Afforestation to be carried over 3.31 Ha degraded forest land.
- vii. The user agency shall construct complete retaining/breast walls on both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slides.
- viii. The extraction of trees shall be done by SFC/Forest Department on the basis of marked list duly approved by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan and Research
- Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees, contractors or ix. people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency @ ten times the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.
- The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department, when it is no longer required by the user agency without any cost.
- The user agency shall deposit the amount of Compensation for the forest land xi. diverted, the compensation for 448 trees felled and compensation for the damage done with the DFO Reasi. However the cost of compensatory afforestation shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K Govt., as per SRO-203 dated 13.04.2000.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 27th meeting Lild under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 01.12.2004.
