Subject: Diversion of Forest Land for construction of Badooab-Checkwali Road Bandipora Forest Division.

Government Order No: 40/FST of 2005

Dated: 1/4005

Sanction is accorded to the diversion of Forest Land measuring 7.65 Hectares falling under compartment No:31/T to 33/T of Block Badooab, Range Gurez, of Bandipora Forest Division for instruction of Badooab-Checkwali Road by 109 RCC GREF/C/O 56 APO (Beacon project) on the lowing conditions:

1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.

2. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.

3. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.

4. The User Agency shall pay Net Present Value of Forest land 7.65 hac. as would be assessed by the concerned DFO as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 30-10-2002 in I.A. No: 566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No: 202 of 1995 T.N.Godavarman Thirumlakpad V/S Union of India.

5. The User Agency shall pay Rs. 3, 50,000/-on account of compensatory afforestation to be carried over 15,30 Ha.

6. The extraction of trees shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/Forest Department on the basis of marking list approved by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle.

7. The user agency will construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips.

8. The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department when it is no longer required by the User Agency without any cost.

9. The user agency shall get done Environment Impact Assessment and also prepare the Environment Management Plan as required in the Environment Protection Act before taking up the work.

The money on account of various heads to be paid by the user agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the office of PCCF.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its  $30^{th}$  meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 16.8.2005.
