Proposal to allow use of 0.10 hectare of forest land for construction of Filtration Plant and other allied infrastructure along the side of Tangmarg-Drung road for Water Supply Scheme HARIWATNOO-KILWARA by PHE Department in Pir Panjal Forest Division.

Government Order No. 263 **FST of 2009**

Sanction is accorded to the use of 0.10 ha of forest land falling under compartment No. 48/C (S.C.Unit Mahaen), Block Soil Block Tangmarg, Range Soil Range Budgam, Pir Panjal Forest Division. (Distt. Budgam) in favour of the Executive Engineer, F.B. Irrigation Division, Tangmarg for construction of Filtration Plant and other allied infrastructure along the side of Tangmarg-Drung road for Water Supply Scheme HARIWATNOO-KILWARA by PHE Department, on the following terms and conditions:-

- 1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 2. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- 3. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
- The User Agency shall pay pay Rs. 69,900/- towards Net Present Value of the forest land to be used.
 - The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land.
 - The User Agency shall take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction activity.
- Any damage done to the forest land/crop shall be charged @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and it is rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
- 9. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue.
- 10. The money on account of various heads to be paid by the User Agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of Pr.Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.

The proposal stands cleared by the Advisory Committee in its 45th meeting held on 9.3..2009 (Agenda item No.45.12).
