

GOVERNMENT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR CIVIL SECTT. FOREST DEPARTMENT.

Subject:-

Proposal to allow use of 2.68 hectare of forest land for construction of small Hydro -Electric Project at Boniyar by Power Development Corporation under IPP (Independent Power Producer) scheme in J.V Forest Division.

Reference: Cabinet Decision No. 65/6/2009 dated 13.06.2009.

Government Order No. 266 FST of 2009 D a t e d: 19-66-2009

Sanction is accorded to the use of 2.68 ha of forest land falling under compartment Nos. 35,37,38 & 39 Boniyar, Block Bernate, Range Boniyar, JV Forest Division (District Baramulla) for construction of small Hydro-Electric Project at Boniyar under IPP (Independent Power Producer), in favour of the Chief Engineer, Civil Investigation and Design Wing, Power Dev. Corporation, Bemina, Srinagar on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.

2. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.

3. The user agency i.e; Power Development Corporation shall not lease forest land so allowed for use to the IPP (Independent Power Producer). However, the Competent Authority of the Govt. may lease the forest land in favour of IPP strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions of the State Hydel Policy.

4. The User Agency shall pay the following amount :-

i. Net Present Value

= Rs. 24, 03,960/-

ii. Compensation of 45T/P/S

= Rs. 6,55,970/-

iii. Compensatory Afforestation

= Rs. 1,34,000/-= Rs. 31,93,930

Total = Rs.

5. The extraction of trees/poles will be done by J&K State Forest Corporation on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, concerned:

The user agency shall take necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of HEP.

7. The user agency shall not dump the debris on forest land.

8. Any damage done to the forest land/crop shall be charged @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.

9. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after it is rehabilitated properly by the user agency.

10. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue.

11. The money on account of various heads to be paid by the User Agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of Pr.Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
