Sub: Diversion of 0.373 hectares Forest Land for widening of Kishtwar -Sinthan road through Comptt. No. 66 b/K , Kishtwar Forest Division, Kishtwar.

Sanction is hereby accorded for diversion of 0.373 hectares forest land under section 2b (ii) of Forest (Conservation) Act of 1997 in Comptt. No: 66 b/K of Kishtwar Forest Division in District Doda for widening of Kishtwar - Sinthan road by GREF in Kishtwar through Comptt. No. 66 b/K on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.
3. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
4. The user agency shall pay compensation of land on account of change of land use which shall be equivalent to cost of land as assessed by competent Revenue Authorities.
5. The user agency shall pay Rs. 389420 on account of compensation of trees to be felled @ two times of the standard rate of 1992.
6. The user agency shall pay Rs. 15000 for the compensatory afforestation over degraded Forest land to the extent of twice the Forest land being diverted.
7. The user agency shall also pay Rs. 75050 on account of damage to existing structures (chain link fencing, fence posts) falling in the alignment of the road.
8. The extraction of trees shall be carried out by State Forest Corporation on the basis of marking list duly approved by CF , Working Plan and Research Circle.
9. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from user agency at the rate of ten times the standard rate of 1992.
10. The user agency will construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips.
11. The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department when it is not required by the user agency without any costs.
