Sub: - Construction of link Road from FDL 501 Batra Gala to FDL 505.

Sanction is hereby accorded for diversion of 2.228 Ha. forest land for the Construction of link Road from FDL 501 Batra Gala to FDL 505 by 31 BRTF (GREF) filling in Compartment No. 18/Rajouri Forest Division under J&K Forest (Conservation) Act Section (2) Sub-Section 1(a) clause (ii) on the following terms and conditions :-

1. The proprietary status of the forestland shall remain unchanged.
2. The forestland so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.
3. The forestland so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
4. The compensation for land on account of change of land use which is equivalent to the cost of land yet to be assessed by Revenue Authorities shall be payable by the user agency.
5. The user agency shall pay Rs. 3,85,850/- on account of compensation for 49 number of Chir green trees of different dia- classes @ two times of the standard rate of 1992.
6. The user agency shall pay Rs. 1,91,290/- towards compensatory afforestation to be carried out over 4.576 Ha. of degraded forest land.
7. The user agency shall construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slides.
8. The extraction of trees shall be done by SFC/Forest Department on the basis of marking list duly approved by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle.
9. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees, contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency @ ten times the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.
10. The forestland so diverted shall return to the Forest Department when it is no longer required by the user agency without any costs.
11. The user agency shall deposit the amount of compensatory afforestation in the office of the Pr. Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K Govt. as per SRO-203 dated 13-04-2000. The compensation for the forest land diverted, compensation for the trees sacrificed and the compensation for any damage done shall be deposited with the DFO, Rajouri.
