
Subject:- Diversion of forest land for construction of Bagga Gulabgarh road by PWD.


ORDER No: 22-FC of 2006.

DATED No: 28-02-2006.

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Sanction is hereby accorded for the diversion of forest land to the extent of 2.23 ha for construction of Bagga Gulabgarh road in Comptt. 14/GG of Mahore Forest Division by PWD strictly under the provisions of J&K Forest Conservation Act on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary status of the forest land shall remain un-changed.
2. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.
3. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
4. The User Agency shall pay the Net Present Value of the land as would be assessed by the concerned Divisional Forest Officer as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Order Dt: 30.10.2002 in I.A. No: 566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No: 202 of 1995 T.N. Godavarman Thirumalpad V/s Union of India.
5. The User Agency shall be bound to pay an amount of Rs.1602180/- on account of compensation of 423 numbers of trees poles.
6. The User agency shall pay Rs.90,000/- on account of compensatory afforestation to be carried over double the area i.e.4.50 Ha
7. The extraction of trees shall be done by State Forest Corporation/Forest Department on the basis of marking list approved by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle.
8. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from user agency at the rate of ten times the standard rate of 1992.
9. The user agency shall take all necessary steps to check soil erosion likely to occur due to the intending construction.
10. The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department when it is no longer required by the User Agency without any cost.
11. The user agency shall also pay any other amount which will become payable as per orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court or Government/Forest Department, J&K.
12. The user agency shall submit an undertaking that in case of any upward revision of rates of Net Present Value, the user agency will pay the amount of differential Net Present Value.
13. The money on account of various heads to be paid by the user agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the office of PCCF.
