DATE: 31 -- 01-2009

Sub:- *The use of 2.5 hectare of forest land for Improvement of road to Class-9 surface specification from Machhal to T-Suntwari (length 9.32 Km.) by GREF in Kamraj Forest Division.*

Ref:- CCF Kashmir's No:CCF(K)/L/09/2820-21 dated.09.01.2009.

As recommended by the Committee (constituted under Section 2 "Proviso 2" of the J&K Forest Conservation Act, 1997) in a meeting held on 03.01.2009 under the chairmanship of Chief Conservator of Forests, Kashmir, the use of forest land to the extent of **2.50 Ha.** from **Comptt. No: 30, 31, 33 & 34/machhal of Kamraj Forest Division** for **Improvement of road to Class-9 surface specification from Machhal to T-Suntwari (length 9.32 Km.) by GREF** is allowed strictly under the provisions of J&K Forest (Conservation) Act, 1997, on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary and legal status of the forest land shall remain un-changed.
2. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
3. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner whatsoever to any other agency.
4. The User Agency shall pay the **Net Present Value of the land to the tune of Rs.24,77,500 (@ Rs.9.91 lac per hectare for Very Dense Forest and Eco Value Class VI)** as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Order Dt:28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in I.A. No: 826 in 566 with related IAs in Writ Petition (Civil) No: 202 of 1995 T.N. Godavarman Thirumalpad V/s Union of India.
5. The User Agency shall pay an amount of **Rs.3,15,120/-** on account of compensation @ two times the standard rate of 1992 for the following number of trees/poles:-

6. The User Agency shall pay **Rs.1,25,000/-** on account of Compensatory Afforestation of Degraded Forest for twice the area diverted i.e. 5 Ha.
7. The extraction of trees/poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation on the basis of markings technically sanctioned by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan and Research Circle, and administratively approved by Chief Conservator of Forests, Kashmir.
8. The User Agency shall construct retaining/breast walls and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road.
9. The User agency shall not dump the debris on forest land.
10. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from user agency at the rate of ten times the standard rate of 1992.
11. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency..
12. The user agency shall be responsible to obtain requisite clearances under any other law in vogue.
13. The money amounting to **Rs.29,17,620/-** on account of various heads to be paid by the user agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the office of Pr. Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
