**Sub** Proposal for use of 0.877 hectare of forest land for construction of road from Duri to Ghan by PMGSY in Kishtwar Forest Division.

**Ref** CCF Jammu's office No: CCF/J&K/1809/1 Dated: 13.12.2010

As recommended by the Committee constituted under Section 2 of the J&K Forest Conservation Act 1997 in a meeting held on 29.11.2010 under the chairmanship of Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu, the use of forest land to the extent 0.877 Ha. of forest land from Comptt. No. 134K in Kishtwar Range of Kishtwar Forest Division for construction of road from Duri to Ghan under PMGSY (as allowed under the provision of the Forest Conservation Act, 1997 on the following terms and conditions:

1. The proprietary and legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indicated.
3. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner but over to any other agency.
4. The User Agency shall pay the Net Present Value of the land to the tune of **Rs.7,86,700/- (or Rs.894/- per hectare for 0.877 Ha. Dense Forest and Eco Value Class VI** as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Order Dated 03.05.2008 and 09.05.2008 in I.A. No: 826 in 566 with related IAs in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 90 of 1992, P. Godavarman Thirumalpad V/s Union of India.
5. The User Agency shall pay an amount of **Rs 5,01,684/-** on account of compensation at two times the standard rate of 1992 for the following number of Trees/poles/Saplings.

6. The extraction of Trees/Poles/ shall be done by the State Forest Corporation / State Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The Cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency..
7. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls as per approved plan and design and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road. The User Agency shall seek technical guidance in this respect from Director, J&K Soil Conservation Department. A copy of the plan and design of the proposed road shall be made available to the Forest Department.
8. The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land and it shall be dumped on separate dumping sites. Area of dumping sites will be included for additional diversion by the User Agency, if it is not included in the present Proposal.
9. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from user agency at the rate of ten times the standard rate of 1992.
10. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
11. The user agency shall be responsible to obtain requisite clearances under any other law in vogue.
12. The money amounting to **Rs. 12,88,384/-** on account of various heads to be paid by the user agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the office of Pr. Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K through two separate cheques / Demand Drafts for Net Present Value & others.
