

- 4. Subsequently, the FAC issued the following directions for observance by the concerned.
 - Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF) has granted a special dispensation wherein powers have been delegated to States in regard to certain matters in LWE areas. Forest Department was advised to access this delegation based upon which process an appropriate proposal for consideration of the competent authority by 05-08-2018.
 - ii. While submitting the proposal to connect any habitation with the main road, the Keyhole Markup Language (KMZ) file should also display the main road to which the proposed road shall get connected.
 - iii. The User Agencies shall consult the Officers of Forest Department at the project conceptualization stage so as to work out proposals with such alignment as would ensure minimum felling of trees and maximum preservation of flora and fauna.
 - iv. The details of the amount recovered on account of roadside plantations be placed before the FAC. Further, expenditure incurred on roadside plantations (District wise) be also placed before the FAC for perusal.
 - v. Forest Department shall submit a report in tabulated form with regard to the cases cleared by FAC since January 2010 with specific mention as to whether the terms and conditions in each case have been duly satisfied or not.
 - vi. The Forest Department will processed a proposal on setting up of an effective and robust monitor mechanism from the conceptual stage to implementation stage to ensure strict observance of FAC conditions in future case(s) for the next FAC meeting.
