AGENDA ITEM NO: 48.01

SUBJECT :- Proposal to allow use of 3.75 hectare of forest land for setting-up of “Modern Abattoir” at Jagti (Nagrota) by Jammu Municipal Corporation in Jammu Forest Division.

As regards the proposal to construct “Modern Abattoir”, a power point presentation was made by Shri. Bakhta, Programme Monitoring Agency (PMA) Ministry of Food Processing Industries, Govt. of India, before the members of FAC to highlight the process involved in the slaughtering of animals and disposal of waste material generated during the process. Shri. Sadiq Ali, Ex-MLA, raised his concerns regarding lack of foolproof mechanism to dispose of discarded waste from the abattoir. His concerns were discussed in detail and all apprehensions were addressed to his satisfaction. The Commissioner/Secretary, Housing and Urban Development Department expressed the urgency of implementing the Project. The Commissioner, Municipal Corporation explained in detail about the project and also highlighted the provision of raising green cover in and around the project area. The Chairman said that minimum number of trees shall be sacrificed for developmental projects and double the area be afforested to compensate for the loss.

ADVISORY COMMITTEE DECISION

The Advisory Committee cleared the diversion of the above forest land for construction of “Modern Abattoir” in favour of Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Jammu, with the condition that the user agency will obtain all other mandatory clearances in advance as required under law and the DFO concerned will ensure that minimum number of trees are felled in the said forest area and that there is proper disposal of the liquid and solid waste generated by the abattoir away from and outside the forest area. The clearance is also subject to the following conditions:

1. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
3. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
4. The User Agency shall pay the following amount after the forest clearance is accorded :-

7. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after it is rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
8. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue.

A copy of the plan and design of the proposed road shall be made available to the Forest Department.
7. The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land.

The Advisory Committee cleared the diversion of the above forest land for construction of proposed road in favour of Project Director, NHAI PIU, Jammu, with the condition that DFO concerned will ensure that no felling is done in the said forest area and subject to the following terms and conditions :

1. The conditions imposed by the Chief Wildlife Warden will be strictly complied with, which are as under :-
 - i. The User Agency should follow the Eco-friendly Engineering Practices during the construction.
 - ii. User Agency should regularly monitor the ambient Air Quality and Noise Levels at the construction site and at two locations in the Conservation Reserve to be finalized with officials of the Department of Wildlife Protection monthly and should submit results to Department of Wildlife Protection.

- iii. The construction site should be covered from all the four sides which will reduce air pollution by windborne constructing material and reduce noise levels.
- iv. Regular sprinkling of water should be carried out on site for dust suppression and construction material will be kept moist wherever possible.
- v. The User Agency, should while implementing the Environment Management Plan will abide by the orders to be issued by Court and follow provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Wildlife Protection Act 1978 (Amended upto 2002).
- vi. National Highway Authority of India will report compliances regularly to the Department of Wildlife Protection.
- vii. Local people should be given preference in employment to minimize the impact on Wildlife due to influx of people should be given preference in employment to minimize the impact on Wildlife due to influx of people.
- viii. All the staff involved in the construction will be informed about the do's and don't in Jawahar Tunnel Conservation Reserve.
- ix. Environment monitoring committee should be formed consisting of NHAI's representative and Wildlife Official under the Chairmanship of Regional Wildlife Warden, Jammu.
- x. No construction debris or muck generated due to the construction of Department of Wildlife Protection, Jammu and Kashmir for Conservation and Preservation of Wildlife and its habitat.
- xi. User Agency should pay 5% of the cost of the Project of the Department of Wildlife Protection, Jammu and Kashmir for Conservation and Preservation of Wildlife and its habitat.
- xii. A fixed percentage of Toll revenue collected by the User Agency from the User Agency passing through the diverted area of Jawahar Tunnel Conservation Reserve should be paid to Department of Wildlife Protection, Jammu and Kashmir to meet the recurring of maintenance and protection of Jawahar Tunnel Conservation Reserve.
