Decision of the Forest Advisory Committee:

The committee approved the Proposal to allow use of 150 Ha. of Forest land for establishment of Central University, Jammu at Village Bagla, Samba In Jammu Forest Divn. by Higher Education Department on the following terms and conditions:

1. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
3. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
4. The extraction of the trees shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/State Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.
5. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls as per approved plan and design and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the building/infrastructure. The User Agency shall seek technical guidance in this respect from the Director, J&K Soil Conservation Deptt. A copy of the plan and design of the proposed building/infrastructure shall be made available to the Forest Department.
6. The construction activities shall be confined to the areas which involve minimum felling in the interest of preservation of environment and ecology of the area as the project involves construction of office buildings and other infrastructure for establishment of university.
7. The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land and it shall be dumped on separate dumping sites. Area of dumping sites will be included for additional diversion by the User Agency if not included in the present proposal.
8. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
9. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
10. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue.
11. The money on account of net present value, CA and others to be paid by the User Agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the office of Pr. CCF, J&K through two cheques as follows :-

12. The user agency shall formulate appropriate soil conservation management plan in consultation with Soil Conservation Department of J&K Govt. in view of the fact that the huge area is involved where heavy cutting/felling has to done.
13. The sanction will remain valid for 2 years and in case the construction of works is not taken up within this period by the user agency, the sanction will be automatically cancelled.

14. The user agency shall prominently display the terms and conditions as approved by the competent authority at the site for information of all the concerned and public.
15. The natural water courses/water ways should not be disturbed while felling of trees and care should be taken to prevent any restriction on natural flow of water, over ground and underground
16. As far as possible natural groves be preserved and requisite greenery shall be maintained in the University.
17. For landscaping and maintaining natural greenery in the University a Committee of experts shall be constituted and Forest Department officials shall also be included in the Committee.
18. It shall be ensured that minimum number of trees is felled for construction of infrastructure for the University so as to maintain greenery in the University.
19. It shall be the endeavour of the University Authorities to plant double the number of trees that are felled in the University Campus.
20. There is involvement of 1465 Khair trees which shall not be felled as per the Ban imposed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
21. The buildings of the University, should grow vertically instead of horizontally i.e. they should be multi-storeyed, so that they take less space and therefore, less number of trees would be involved. While deciding the layout for the infrastructure forest officials should be consulted.
