(c) the resultant impact assessed in terms of ecological parameters, and (d) the future environmental safeguards to be adopted so as to keep the ecological balance always undisturbed.
59.09	Proposal to allow use of 9.57 hectare of forest land for dumping sites and diversion approaches for Mandial Bridge and Tunnel under Sawalakote Hydro-Electric Project by J&K SPDC in Batote Forest Division.	The proposal was deferred on the ground that the User Agency on one hand dumped the excavated material (generated due to construction of External Access Road) to their suitability on forest land without prior approval under FCA and on the other damaged the vegetative cover. Revised proposal was required to be submitted after taking into account the following:- (a) Violation of the terms and conditions as laid down in the Government Order No:533-FST of 2003 Dated 08.12.2003 for construction of External Access Road to Sawalakot HEP. (b) Cognizance of the damage taken by the concerned territorial staff. (c) Identification of the suitable dumping sites for the excavated material to be generated due to construction of the remaining part of the External Access Road.

59.15	Proposal to allow use of 142.56 hectare of forest land for construction of 690 MW Rattle Hydro Electric Project at Drabshalla by the JK SPDC in Doda and Kishtwar Forest Divisions.	The proposal was deferred as some additional information was required to be furnished as under: (a) Number of trees, poles and saplings involved to be given separately for each component i.e. main project, submergence, muck dumping and realignment of NH-1B. (b) The suitable dumping sites over the requisite forest land of 18.45 hectare to be identified, enlisted and shown on the map after joint survey of the area by the Forest Department and the Indenting Agency. With this additional information incorporated in the proposal, the Forest Advisory Committee required the Indenting Agency to give presentation about the Project in a meeting to be convened separately for the purpose so that all issues related to the proposal could be discussed and deliberated upon at length.
59.16	Revised proposal to allow use of 25.42 hectare of forest land for widening of Bandipora Gurez road, Phase-II, (Km. 42 to Km. 86) by GREF in Bandipora Forest Division.	The proposal was cleared on the terms and conditions as laid down in the proposal.
59.17	Proposal to allow use of 0.125 hectare of forest land for construction of earthen Impounding Reservoir at Gagar/ Shumnari (Yousmarg) by PHE in Pir Panjal Forest Division.	The proposal was cleared on the terms and conditions as laid down in the proposal.
59.18	Issue regarding requirement of boulders, stone, bajri etc. by the GREF for construction of roads.	The Forest Advisory Committee was of the view that the proposal can be considered on case to case basis under the provisions of the guidelines/rules of the J&K Forest (Conservation) Act,1997.
