- 2. Pr. Chief Conservator of Forests will take the input from the Director SFRI for the development of technology for "Transplantation of Saplings" to brief the FAC in the next meeting.
- 3. Chairman enquired about the development of the submission of the proposal "Improvement of track conditions to Holy Cave of Shri Amarnathji (Baltal route and Pahalgam route)". Conservator of forests, Srinagar Circle briefed about the development. Chairman desired to finalize the proposal.
- 4. Monitoring mechanism for the projects already approved needs to be in place to ensure compliance of stipulated terms and conditions.
- 5. Pr. Chief Conservator of Forests briefed the FAC about the submission of proposal of "Diversion of Forest land for the construction of Zojila tunnel". Proposal submitted is short of many vital information. The Chief Conservator of Forests (Kashmir) has been requested to take the information from BEACON and submit the complete proposal.
- 6. The Chief Engineer (PMGSY), Jammu will issue instruction to all the Ex. Engineers to submit the information to the respective DFOs regarding Muck dumping sites, Breast/Retaining walls and complete DPR of the case as directed by FAC in its 78th meeting.
