- B. The Committee observed that the Index maps being submitted by the User Agencies should be duly signed by the officers not below the rank of the Divisional Forest Officer and Executive Engineer. The Divisional Forest Officer and the Executive Engineer concerned should carry out the joint inspection of the site together.
- C. A process of monitoring of the roads constructed under PMGSY should be developed by the Chief Engineer (PMGSY).
