



"Chief Secretary observed that certain directions have been issued in the 97th meeting held on 20.05.2017 which need to be followed strictly while implementing the decisions in respect of the approved proposals. He made it clear that monitoring be intensified and supervised by the concerned DFO himself. It was further observed that before rolling out PMGSY projects, there is a need to seek prior consultation from the Forest Department to facilitate construction of roads as per the timelines. For this purpose, a separate meeting of the concerned officers will be convened to work of the modalities. It was also decided that CE PMGSY will give a report on the roads passing through forest area and their general impact."
